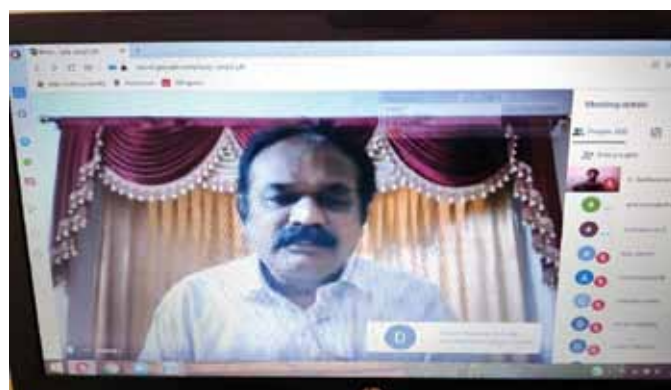
WELCOMING THE NEW HOD

“If agriculture goes wrong, nothing else will have a chance to go right”

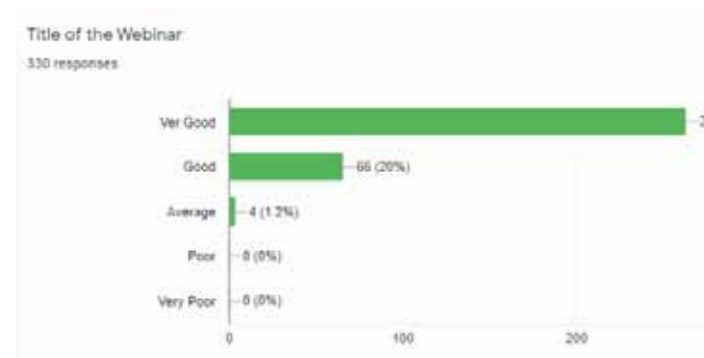

DEPARTMENT MEETINGS

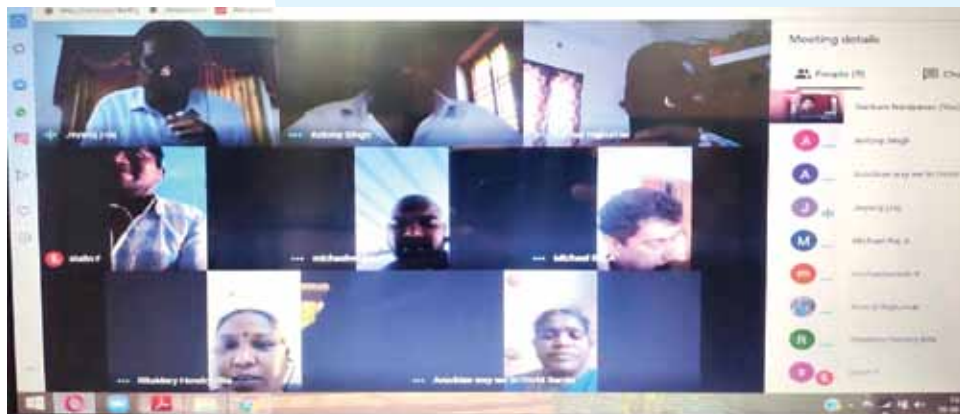


6TH AUGUST 2020
