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ANNEXURE — I

General Conditions

1. The College should strictly adhere to the eligibility conditions prescribed by the University / Government in admitting candidates for the courses offered and also to the said courses.
2. The College should not admit students over and above the strength sanctioned by the University.
3. No amount should be collected from the students in excess of the fees prescribed by the University / Government or donations for appointment of persons for both teaching and non-teaching positions.
4. College should adhere to the Tamil Nadu Government Reservation Policy in admitting candidates and appointment of staff.
5. There shall be no financial commitment on the part of the State Government of University on account of the courses being started by the college.
6. The college should pay salary to the teachers as prescribed by the Government / UGC.
7. The college should provide space and facilities to the University to conduct examinations and for other academic purposes as and when required.
8. The Course noted above has only be granted as Self Financing Course.
9. The students shall be permitted to appear for the First Semester examination only after 90 working days from the date of receipt of this affiliation order.
10. The management should get the Continuance of affiliation for the above said courses every year.
11. The Management should obtain the approval from the University for the appointment of teaching staff.
12. The management should select the Optional/ Ancillary Subject for the above courses in consultation with the Controller of Examinations of the University.
13. Approved Syllabus can be had from the Board of Studies Section of this University.

ANNEXURE - II

Specific Conditions

1. Multiple copies of text books should be added in the Library.
2. The following Journals should be subscribed for the Library:
 - a) Computer Application; b) Journal of Computation
 - c) PCWorld; d) Data Quest; e) IEEE Journals on Electronics and Computer.
3. The existing 5 KVA UPS may be replaced by a 10KVA and or add one more 5KVA with 1 hour backuptime.
4. Internet connection should be obtained in about six months time either with a dedicated DCT line or VSAT terminal. Till then, a pseudo server with three terminals should be made available.
5. The College should make up the minimum number of working days by working extra days and time.

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RECOMMENDATIONS AND SUGGESTIONS OF THE MADURAI KAMARAJ UNIVERSITY
INSPECTION COMMISSION

1. AICTE approval must be obtained.
2. The following Computer facilities must be added in addition to the existing facilities.
 - (a) One more server for Unix operating system should be procured.
 - (b) Existing '16 MB RAM' nodes must be upgraded to 32 MB.
 - (c) Four multimedia work stations must be installed.
 - (d) One internet browsing station must be created.
 - (e) The softwares-UMX, Visual Studio, Oracle and JAVA - must be made available.
3. The laboratory site preparation must be completed and the computers must be installed in a new laboratory.
4. The M.C.A syllabus must be approved by the Academic Council of the College.
5. The existing lab is not sufficient for M.C.A programme and the proposed lab with modifications should be completed.
6. Additional 2 nodes of 32 MB should be procured and two more servers should be procured.
7. Computer Science Journals and CD-ROM tutorials should be procured.
8. The Furniture for the Lab should be purchased and installed.
9. The budget provisions for the recurring and non-recurring should be made for Lab / Equipments / Library / Building / accommodations.

The AICTE, New Delhi has accorded its approval to the above College to start the M.C.A. course (full time - three years) with an intake of thirty students for the academic year 1999-2000.
