In accordance to it, the first meeting for NIRF took place in Prince Hall on 17.7.2017 at 12.00 pmin the presence of Rev.Dr.S.Basil Xavier SJ, Principal and the committee members.

The meeting commenced with the flow of gracious words of prayer by Ms.R.Josephine Therese, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science and Applications. Rev. Dr. S. Dr.D.Antony Singh Dhas, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, Dr.A. Duraisingam, Librarian, Dr.Nivetha Martin, Assistant Professor, Department of Mathematics had a discussion about the aspect of median salary of the students fixed at time of placement. NIRF EVALUATION MEETING

The evaluation meeting of NIRF ranking 2018 was held on 6th April 2018 at Principal's office in the presence of Rev.Dr.Amal Kulandaisamy, the Rector, Rev.Dr.S.Mani Valan, the Secretary, Rev.Dr.S.Basil Xavier, the Principal, the co-ordinator and the conveners of the core committees.

The meeting commenced with the prayerful words and appreciation to the core committee of NIRF by Rev.Dr.Principal. Dr.A.Shanmugaraju, the coordinator of AAC NIRF presented the status of our college in ranking and its position in the band of 101-150. He also presented a comparative analysis of our college data with other colleges ranked within 100.

Fr.Rector stated that the institution has to undergo an introspection to determine the required areas of improvement. He also insisted that the institution as a whole has to work for its overall enhancement.

Dr.A.Thomas William, Dean Academic stated that the entire ranking of NIRF is quantitative rather than qualitative. It was indeed accepted by all the other conveners.

Dr.J.A.Charles, Associate Professor & Head of Chemistry expressed and shared his opinion in the forum to improve pass percentage by practicing different strategies bounded to the norms of the Jesuit management of AAC. His suggestions were highly acceptable and the management decided to form three committees to carry out the evaluation of core activities pertaining to the domain of finance, placement and results.

Dr.S.Arul Prasad, Associate Professor of RDS and Placement coordinator suggested certain activities to make the placement cell more vibrant in the forthcoming years.

Dr.A.Shanmugaraju, the coordinator of AAC NIRF thanked the members present in the meeting for their participation and contribution.
