ACHIEVEMENTS IN A NUTSHELL (2020-21)


- 860 farmers were newly added to mobile networking
- A network of 7 FPOs was created
- Upscaling of L3F programme in three new institutions

PROGRAMMES OF ACPR IN 2020-21

1. Expert Panel Meeting for Policy Research Initiative by ACPR

An online panel discussion with the experts was organized by ACPR on 18th November 2021 for its policy research on 'COVID-19 and its implications on small and marginal farmers'. Nine experts shared their expertise on the issue and suggested research planning.





2. Orientation Meeting with Madurai District Coconut and Other Crops Producer Organization and Other Selected FPOs

An orientation meeting was organized in Rev. Dr. J. L. Gnanarethinam, SJ Hall, Arul Anandar College on 20th December 2020 at 11.00 am. The main purpose of this meeting was to initiate the mobile based learning programmes for FPO (Farmer Producer Organization) leaders and to create a network among FPOs. 30 members from seven FPOs participated in this programme.





3. Two Days Training Programme on Producing and Marketing of Coir pith

ACPR aimed at expanding the business activities for the selected coconut FPOs by conducting "Two Days Training Programme on Producing and Marketing of Coir Pith" on 05th & 06th February 2021. The first training was organized in Diraviam Arangam, Arul Anandar college on 05th February 2021 at 10.00 am. 30 Leaders from various FPOs participated in this programme.

On the second day, a hands-on training on producing and marketing was arranged in **Natures Coir Private Limited**, **Periyakulam** on 06th February 2021.









4. A One-day Training Programme on Production and Marketing of Coir pith

Intensive hands-on training on production and marketing of Coir pith was arranged for the selected members of Coconut FPO, Karumathur & Chellampatti FPO on 17th February 2021. The meeting was organized in "Victor Fibers, Sholavanthan, Madurai District. 30 women farmers participated in the training programme.





5. Mobile Learning for Farmers through MobiMOOC

A MobiMOOC on "The Livestock Disease Management in Summer" was conducted for 1500 farmers in collaboration with IIT – Kanpur. It was formally launched on 11th April 2021. The main agenda of this MobiMOOC was to address the learning needs of farmers. The list of 1500 participants was identified by conducting Focus Group Discussion and continuous filed visits.





6. Upscaling of L3F (Lifelong Learning for Farmers) in the Academic Institutions

A Two-Day workshop on "Upscaling of L3F" was organized in Germanus Hotel, Madurai on 23rd and 24th July 2021. The objective of this workshop was to upscale the Career Oriented Course on 'Multimedia for Lifelong Learning and ODL' in the academic institutions. Representatives of 20 academic institutions participated in the workshop.

- Promoting organic farming
- Empowering agricultural extension department with the latest information technology which, in turn, will enable rapid transfer of information to farmers
- Conserving irrigation water
- Preserving and encouraging conventional/ wild varieties in agriculture and horticulture
- · Expanding mechanization of agricultural work.
- Promoting effective utilization of solar energy for agricultural work
- Strengthening of farm ponds and various other water resources
- Revising the marketing strategies to enable profitable prices for the farmers

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
